1. No Visitors This Drill. This drill will be for enrolled cadets only or those visitors authorized by the CO.

2. Summer Training Issues:

Request for Training Authority. This form must be signed by the CO and mailed to National Headquarters in VA. If you have not already submitted your Request please do so IMMEDIATELY.

Medical Forms. The Medical History (NSCADM20) should have been mailed to INSTR Montoya. If you are bringing ANY medication to training (prescription or non-prescription) you must also complete the Supplemental Medical Form (NSCTNG25). The NSCTNG25 must be signed by the medical provider if prescription medication will be brought to Camp Williams. Non-prescription pain medication like Tylenol, Ibuprofen, Aspirin should not be brought to training. It will be issued by the medical officer as needed.

Sea Bag Inspection. All items listed on the Sea Bag list for summer training should be brought to drill in the approved foot locker specified on the Sea Bag list.

Name and Branch Tapes for Utilities. Name tapes and UNSCC or USNLCC branch tapes will be mailed this week along with instructions on where they should be sewn. Flashes will be sent to all those who have emailed the CO that they need them. BDU name tapes and branch tapes will be mailed to cadets attending POLA, staff cadets and cadets who have completed the BMR. Cadets attending Recruit Training who have completed the BMR may wear BDU's this drill if they have been issued a full uniform. They will not wear BDU's at summer training. They will wear Utilities.

Welcome Letter Corrections: POLA cadets will arrive at training in BDU's. Graduation time has been changed to noon.

Summer Training Q&A. Parents are welcome to attend a Q&A on Sunday at 1330 to ask any remaining questions on summer training. Those who signed up to help prepare meals should also attend.

3. **Awards Ceremony.** Many cadets were advanced and received awards at the June Awards Ceremony. Of special note were the advancement of PO3 Andrew Martinez and Alex Mortensen. Congratulations to these new Petty Officers. Also notable was the awarding to PO2 Bunting of both the Physical Fitness and Color Guard Ribbons – two ribbons that are difficult to earn. Many recruiting ribbons were also awarded.
4. **New Sea Cadet LPO.** PO3 Martinez relieved PO2 VanHulten as the Leading Petty Officer for the Great Salt Lake Division. BZ to PO2 VanHulten for her service as LPO for the last two years. She will serve as a Staff Cadet at Navy League Orientation and then end her time as a cadet and enter our Wardroom as a Midshipman. We look forward to having her continue to serve the unit in this new capacity.
5. **Upcoming Drill Schedule:** Cadets will not drill in August but we are looking at optional events in August that cadets can participate in. All officers who have not attended OPD 101 will be attending that course that weekend (14-15AUG). We will also hold a full day Wardroom meeting that weekend. September drill will be 18/19SEP. Enrolled cadets will spend most of this drill at the Utah Fairpark supporting Salt Lake City Navy Week.
5. **PT Gear is required at every drill.** Appropriate PT gear: sweat pants or long shorts, short-sleeved T-shirt or sweatshirt, running shoes, and socks. You should also bring a bottle of water marked with your name. **Bring PT gear on both days this drill.** We will conduct a PRT this drill.
6. **Lunch: Cadets are responsible for providing their own lunch.** Cadets will be able to purchase lunch on Saturday at the PX. The PX is closed on Sunday. Cadets are not permitted to leave the post for lunch.
