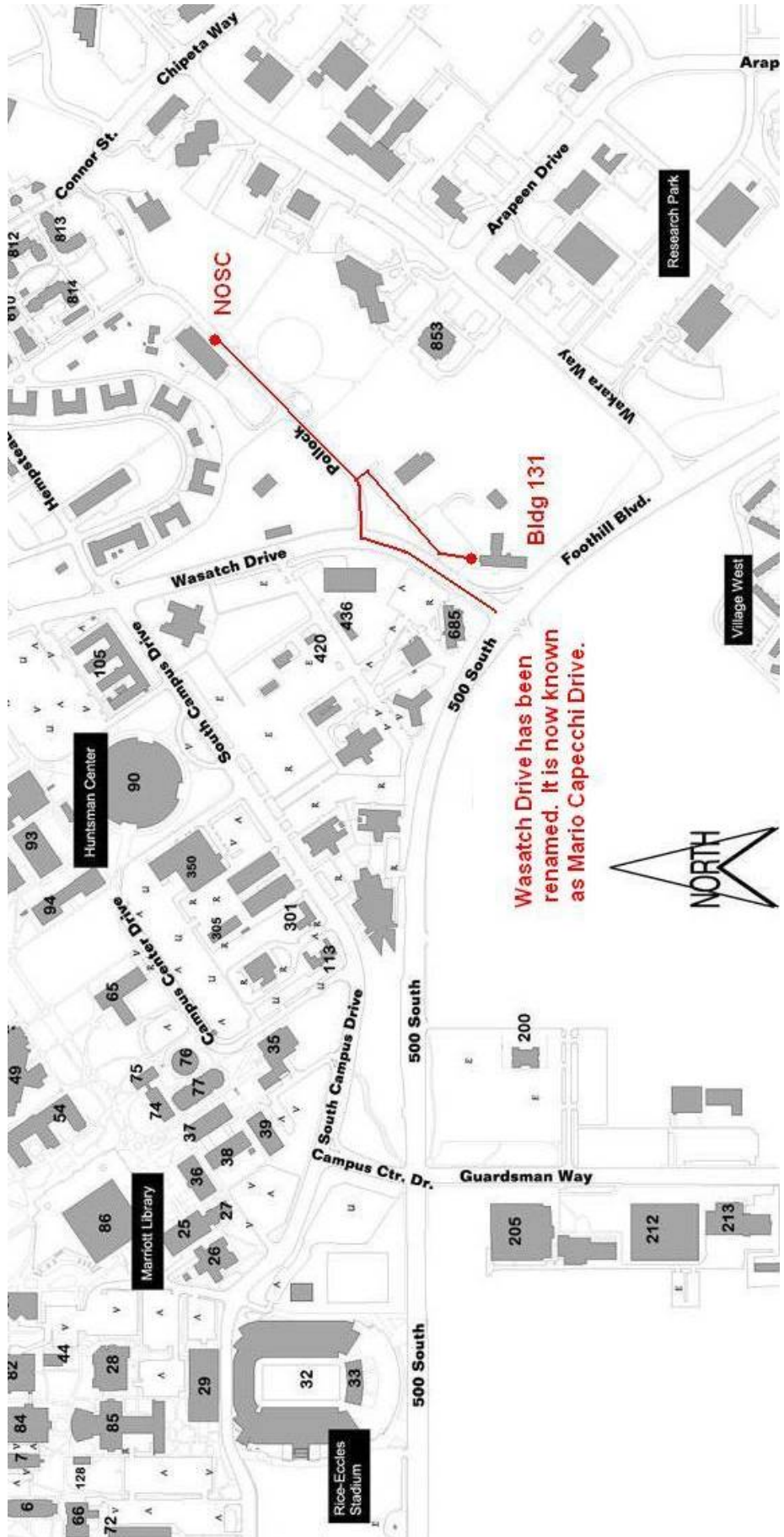
A complete Seabag should be brought by all cadets even if you are not overnighing.
